

VISITOR AND OPERATIONAL RULES

Climbing Center HANGAR BRNO

Operator: VerticalBlock s.r.o., ID: 054 88 648
Address: Pražákova 1027/53, 619 00 Brno-střed

The climbing wall operated by the operator (hereinafter referred to as the "wall") is intended exclusively for the training of the sports activity of bouldering and free climbing (hereinafter referred to as "climbing"), for climbing training as part of physical education classes, and for organizing competitions.

All visitors to the climbing center are required to familiarize themselves with these Visitor Rules (hereinafter referred to as the "Rules"). The current version of the Rules is available at the entrance desk and on the information board in the climbing wall area.

Visitors acknowledge the Rules by **signing the entry form or through online registration** during their first visit to the climbing center. By signing, visitors confirm they have read, understood, and agree to adhere to the Rules and the prescribed behavior on the wall.

Visitor: Any person present in the climbing center, whether actively climbing or supervising another person, or staying in any other part of the facility (locker rooms, bar, gym).

Expert Supervision (Service): A person designated by the operator to oversee activities.

Bouldering Climber: A climber practicing without belaying above mats.

Adolescents: Individuals aged 13–18 years.

Child: Individuals under 13 years.

Parent: The supervising adult responsible for the child.

By paying the admission fee or entering the facility, each visitor agrees to all conditions of the Rules.

Visitors must purchase an identification chip for the climbing center during their first visit.

Climbing activities are conducted at the **visitor's own risk and responsibility**. Visitors must acknowledge potential dangers and ensure they are competent in climbing and belaying techniques, including fall arrest.

Visitors should assess their physical condition and skills before engaging in climbing activities. The operator recommends beginners or inexperienced individuals to train under the supervision of a professional instructor. The operator is not liable for any harm to visitors' health resulting from overestimating their own abilities or physical condition.

The operator strongly advises against engaging in free climbing activities on the climbing wall for individuals with health issues, particularly those with cardiovascular problems, heart conditions, or for pregnant women, among others.

Individuals under the influence of alcohol or drugs are strictly prohibited from entering the climbing wall area or participating in climbing activities. The operator reserves the right to deny access in such cases.

Every visitor over the age of 13 is required to complete an entry form upon entering the climbing wall and confirm their acquaintance with the Rules by signing it. If the form is not completed, access to the wall is prohibited. Upon request by the operator or their authorized representative (reception staff), the visitor must also provide proof of identity and age by presenting an ID or another identification document with a photograph.

Adolescents aged 13 to 18 may independently engage in sports activities on the climbing wall and free climbing only if they provide the operator with written consent from their legal guardian. This consent, available on the operator's website, must state that the guardian agrees to their child independently participating in sports activities on the climbing wall and assumes full responsibility for them. Otherwise, adolescents may engage in sports activities and free climbing on the climbing wall only when accompanied by a person over 18 years of age who assumes responsibility for them.

Children

Entry for individuals under the age of 13 is allowed only under the supervision of a parent or another adult (especially an instructor or coach) who assumes full responsibility for the child. The parent must supervise the child at all times and in all areas of the climbing center throughout the visit.

Unsupervised movement of children (under 6 years old) in the climbing areas, outside the designated children's play park, is prohibited without the presence of an instructor or parent. There is a risk of serious injury. Climbers are not responsible for what happens beneath them while climbing!

Visitors must comply with the instructions provided by the expert supervision designated by the operator at all times. Visitors may rent quality, safe, and fully functional sports equipment designated for climbing from the center. Visitors must use this equipment following the manufacturer's guidelines and recommendations from expert supervision. The operator is not responsible for the condition of visitors' personal equipment.

Every visitor is required to adhere to the following **basic principles and rules of safe climbing** and sports activities on the climbing wall:

- **The bouldering wall is not a playground. Children must not be left unsupervised to run around or climb. Serious injuries may occur if a climber falls onto a child.**
- Minors may climb only under adult supervision or with signed parental consent for adolescents (13–18 years).
- Objects must not be left in the landing area as they can pose risks to climbers during falls.
- Simultaneous climbing by two or more individuals on the same boulder is prohibited.
- Climbing is allowed only with proper climbing footwear.
- The children's movement park may only be accessed in socks, climbing shoes, or clean sneakers.
- Climbing in the children's play park or movement park is prohibited for adults when children are present.
- Visitors must not remain in the landing area unless actively climbing.
- Rescue or support of a climber is permitted.
- Use only designated holds and structures for climbing.

- Climbing on the outer side of the children's towers is prohibited.
- Food and drink are not allowed in the children's movement park.

Groups of more than 10 visitors must notify the center of their visit at least 7 days in advance via email at info@hangarbrno.cz. If a group fails to notify the center and the wall is crowded, the group may be denied access.

Visitors must immediately report any observed technical defects on the climbing wall, such as loose holds or malfunctioning belaying equipment, to expert supervision. Visitors should also warn others intending to use a compromised climbing route. In the event of an injury, visitors must provide first aid to the injured person and promptly summon a doctor or the expert supervision, who will handle further assistance.

The expert supervision and climbing wall staff have access to a first-aid kit.

Visitors must maintain cleanliness and order throughout the facility.

Adherence to fire safety regulations and familiarity with the Fire Alarm Directive posted within the facility is mandatory.

Alcohol consumption, smoking, or the use of any substances is strictly prohibited in the climbing areas. Alcohol may only be consumed in designated areas.

Conducting commercial activities within the climbing center is allowed only with the operator's consent.

The operator or expert supervision has the right to eject any individual violating the Rules without a refund of the admission fee. The operator reserves the right to deny entry to repeat offenders.

The operator guarantees the protection of personal data provided by visitors and will process it in accordance with applicable laws.

The operator reserves the right to close specific sections of the climbing wall for private events.

By signing the entry form, visitors express their consent for the operator to process their provided personal data in accordance with Act No. 101/2000 Coll., on the protection of personal data, as amended, for the purpose determined by the operator and for the time necessary to achieve this purpose.

These Rules are binding for all visitors as of the date of publication and are available on the operator's website, at the reception, and within the climbing wall area for review.

The operator may amend or update the Rules at any time.

The operation and rules for visiting and using the training space of the Hangar Rockets Brno club are governed by a separate set of regulations, which is an addendum to these rules.

ADDENDUM TO VISITOR AND OPERATIONAL RULES NO. 1

Visitor and operational rules of Training Spaces of HANGAR ROCKETS Brno

Operator: Hangar Rockets Brno, z.s., ID: 078 70 329

I. Basic Provisions:

The training spaces of the HANGAR ROCKETS Brno club are part of the premises located at Pražákova 53, Brno, Building U, Section B. These spaces are a physically separated part of the sports hall of the Climbing Center Hangar Brno, operated by VerticalBlock s.r.o. (ID: 054 88 648, hereinafter referred to as "the space" or "spaces").

II. Authorized Use and Activities:

The training spaces operated by the above-mentioned operator are intended exclusively for training, continuous practice, and sports preparation in the activities of bouldering and related movement exercises.

These spaces serve solely the activities and interests of the HANGAR ROCKETS Brno club, which organizes and trains youth athletes in bouldering and sport climbing.

The spaces are designated for use only by members of the HANGAR ROCKETS Brno sport climbing club who are properly registered, have paid their membership fees on time, and are youth athletes (hereinafter referred to as "members").

Instructors, trainers, and other authorized individuals may also access and use the spaces.

The operator, authorized staff, and club leaders have the right to monitor and oversee compliance with these rules.

III. Public Access:

Public access to the training spaces is not permitted.

IV. Responsibilities of Club Members:

This operational regulation governs the conditions for using the spaces designated for the activities of the children's climbing club, as defined in Sections I and II of the addendum. Members are required to comply with the Addendum to the Visitor and Operational Rules No. 1, which is the Visitor and Operational Rules for the Training Spaces of the HANGAR ROCKETS BRNO Club (hereinafter referred to as the "addendum"). Additionally, to the extent that the rights and obligations are not regulated by the addendum, members are also required to comply with the Visitor and Operational Rules of the Climbing Center HANGAR BRNO.

IV.I. Entry and Stay in the Spaces:

Members may enter the spaces only under the supervision of an instructor, trainer, or other authorized individual. Members must strictly follow the instructions of their instructors or authorized individuals at all times.

Access to the spaces is only permitted during operating hours determined by the operator.

Members may not leave the training spaces without the consent of their instructors or trainers.

IV.II. Safety Rules:

Members are required to use safety equipment and adhere to all safety procedures during climbing and related activities. Proper hygiene must also be observed.

Members must immediately report any improper use of equipment, rule violations, or damage to equipment or spaces to their instructor.

Members must prioritize their own safety as well as the safety of others during activities.

IV.III. Responsibility for Equipment and Space Management:

After activities, all equipment must be properly cleaned and stored. Members and staff must treat equipment and spaces with care.

Any damage to equipment must be reported to the club leader immediately.

The operator maintains an inventory of equipment, regularly updates it, and ensures its proper condition.

V. Final Provisions:

All club members must comply with the instructions and recommendations of the club leader and operator of the spaces.

The operator reserves the right to change or amend this addendum at any time.

Violations of the operational rules may result in disciplinary consequences.

This operational rule becomes effective immediately upon publication and remains valid until revoked.
